**1** Designed like a disposable with stretchy tab closures, the simplicity of this option is ideal for daycare. The waterproof outer fabric needs no cover, and there's no insert to stuff in. **bum-Genius All-in-One Cloth Diaper | \$16, [cottonbabies.com](http://cottonbabies.com)**

**2** This nappy is simple and snug, with a series of snaps to tighten the fit. The absorbent cotton fleece fabric is sturdy and plush, but requires a diaper cover to prevent leaks. **Kissaluv's Fitted Diaper | \$12, [preciousbottom.com](http://preciousbottom.com)**

**3** Put this cover over any cloth diaper or use with a pre-folded diaper insert. The laminated inner layer stops leaks but only soft knit polyester touches baby. **Bummis Super Whisper Wrap Diaper Cover in Froggy Pond | \$9, [thanksmama.com](http://thanksmama.com)**
